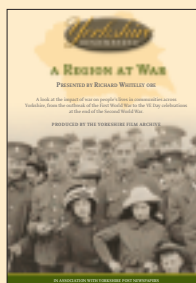


SIX PROGRAMMES FROM THE TREASURES OF THE YORKSHIRE FILM ARCHIVE

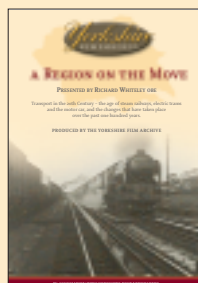
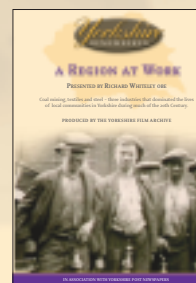

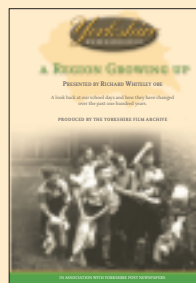

A Region Growing Up

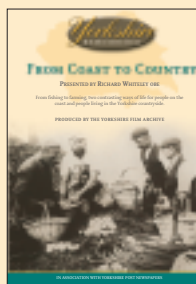

From Coast to Country

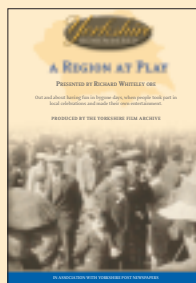
